**Meeting was called to order** by Matt Bezbatchenko at 7:07 pm with 13 members in attendance. An agenda and financial update was available at sign in.

A unanimous motion to accept the **minutes of the September meeting** as emailed out was approved by the membership. The commissioners then reported that in the K and 1 league the training was going very well.
